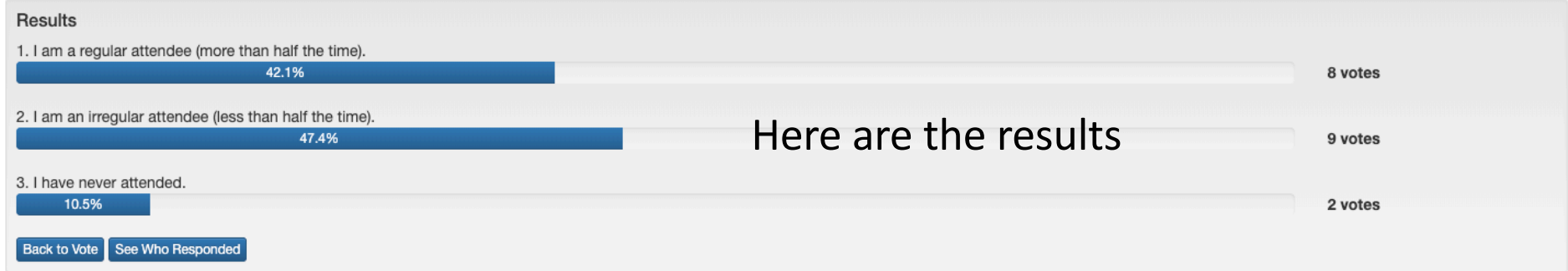

- Currently the recycling team has a subgroup where they post files and notes.
- These tend to be working documents that are not ready to be shared with the whole group

Calendars

- You can view the calendar by month, week, or day
- To create an event just click in the calendar. In month view an event is automatically all day; in week or day view you can set the times

- Please note we have very limited storage! If we get too many photos, we'll have to go through and remove the old ones

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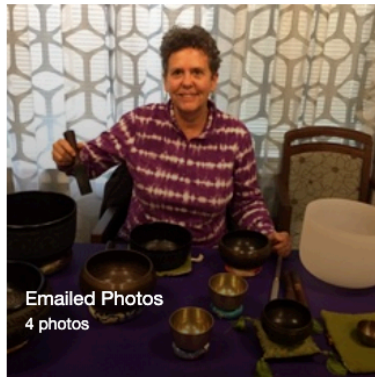

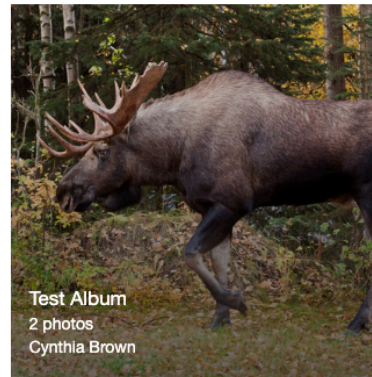

“Database” feature

- Suppose you want to create a signup for an event where everyone brings something, like food to a potluck or cookies to a bake sale
- It would be great for people to be able to see what others are bringing so you don't end up with too many similar items
- This would be a good use for the Database feature. It lets you create a table with rows and columns, such as a list of names in one column and what they're bringing in the next column.

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Index

- Electing Resident Council members by Neighborhood

Create a page with the title of *Home* to replace this page.

A “wiki” is a shared document that can be edited by all members of the group. The best-known example is Wikipedia. The wiki feature is a good way to collaborate on a document that several people are going to contribute to.

 Let's use this topic to experiment with moving from messages/chats about a topic to developing a proposal using a Wiki page (a feature of groups.io). Go to RVChat on groups.io, then select Wiki and click on the topic "Electing Resident Council members by Neighborhood". Click on Edit Page button at bottom to edit; click on Save Page when done.

With a Wiki, we can all add/edit. Please read the page. Type in comments/ideas. If you find a topic where you're willing to do some research, type in your name, the date, and what you'll research. Then come back and add info. We'll see how it works to develop a document collectively.

FYI--In my view, this is primarily a chance for us to practice working together. We may or may not decide to act on this particular topic.

Topic: Electing Resident Council members by neighborhood rather than At Large (campus-wide)

Background:

*Current process for electing Resident Council members (length of term, how many are elected each year, what do Bylaws say, etc.)
 Three Council members are elected each year for a term of three years by members of the Residents Association. Elections are held at the November annual meeting and terms begin the first day of January. The Council determines portfolio assignments of Councilors as described in the Council Procedures Manual.

*History (has neighborhood representation model been used in the past? what were the pros/cons?)

*Current representation by Ready Force neighborhoods (20191116 Added by Steve Morris and Susan Hyne):

This is the beginning of the existing wiki page.

Subgroups

- Subgroups are useful for discussions that are not appropriate for the general group
- People can sign up for a subgroup if they want to but otherwise won't see the subgroup messages
- Possible examples might be:
 - A subgroup for a committee such as the Recycling Team (exists)
 - Pet owners and those willing to care for pets in emergencies
 - People interested in off-campus cultural events who would like to carpool
 - People who want a forum for contentious topics that others might find annoying or offensive

Bottom Line

- You don't have to learn to use all these features to get good use out of RVChat!
- Begin by setting your password, profile, and preferences
- After that, the best place to start is with messages to friends and neighbors about issues, opportunities, questions, problems...
- Make it your own!
