Neighbor to Neighbor Communication

What is RVChat?

- A *communications* system within the groups.io family of message systems
- It is *limited to RV residents* and is designed for resident to resident communication: the kind of thing you would talk to your neighbors about (We now have 79 members, and more coming!)
- It has many nice features to help facilitate communication; we'll review them briefly
- It is a *complement* to, not a replacement for, TouchTown
- It is *moderated*, so messages are monitored for appropriateness

What do I use it for? All kinds of things:


- Finding a pet sitter
- Finding a friend/neighbor to go to an event with
- Looking for people with common interests for a game group or action committee
- Letting people know about something happening in the neighborhood
- Finding someone to take your extra zucchini
- Getting a recipe for a dish you want to try


Using RVChat with email

Using your own email program


- You can send a message to the group right from your own email program
- You can also reply to messages using various options
- For most people, this will be your primary (or even only) way of interacting with RVChat. You never have to learn about other features

The message: note useful links at bottom!





Message "Etiquette"

- Try not to overload the system with messages that are not of general interest.
- If you send a message looking for help with something, it should go to the whole group (I lost my phone!)
- When your issue is resolved, send another message to let everyone know (I found it!)
- Other messages addressing the issue should usually just go to the sender unless there is a reason why everyone needs to see it
- Avoid "courtesy" messages like "Glad you found it" or send them individually, not to the whole group


More on messages...


- You may never need to go to the actual RVChat site once you are signed up. You can start and reply to messages, mute topics, and more from your email
- But you can also start a new message thread from the site by going to the site and then to the Messages area using the left-side menu






Other Features








Coffee with Friends, Thursdays, 9am, Club Room


We decided to try a theme for our next dinner excursion. (Once we have the theme, we'll pick a restaurant.) Should it be:


- Italian

Use a chat when you want to quickly decide an issue

We've decided on Vietnamese food... now let's pick a day, time, and restaurant, and arrange car sharing.

Click the **chat** item in the left side menu, start a new chat, and everyone who is involved can join, share opinions, etc. It's like having a meeting without having to physically get together. It is done live on the site, NOT via email, so you have to let people know when to join in






Example: The Recycling Team

- Currently the recycling team has a subgroup where they post files and notes.
- These tend to be working documents that are not ready to be shared with the whole group


Calendars


- You can view the calendar by month, week, or day
- To create an event just click in the calendar. In month view an event is automatically all day; in week or day view you can set the times



Photos


- The system stores photos and documents that are attached to messages; you can also add photos directly to the Photos section
- You can access the photos through the Photos button
- Please note we have very limited storage! If we get too many photos, we'll have to go through and remove the old ones







"Database" feature

- Suppose you want to create a signup for an event where everyone brings something, like food to a potluck or cookies to a bake sale
- It would be great for people to be able to see what others are bringing so you don't end up with too many similar items
- This would be a good use for the Database feature. It lets you create a table with rows and columns, such as a list of names in one column and what they're bringing in the next column.







Subgroups

- Subgroups are useful for discussions that are not appropriate for the general group
- People can sign up for a subgroup if they want to but otherwise won't see the subgroup messages
- Possible examples might be:
 - A subgroup for a committee such as the Recycling Team (exists)
 - Pet owners and those willing to care for pets in emergencies
 - People interested in off-campus cultural events who would like to carpool
 - People who want a forum for contentious topics that others might find annoying or offensive

Bottom Line

- You don't have to learn to use all these features to get good use out of RVChat!
- Begin by setting your password, profile, and preferences
- After that, the best place to start is with messages to friends and neighbors about issues, opportunities, questions, problems...
- Make it your own!
