

HOW TO RECYCLE #1 CLEAR PLASTIC CONTAINERS

Requirements:

- Must be clear (if tinted or solid color goes in garbage)
- Must be empty, clean and dry
- Labels and adhesive residue are okay

Special note: some #1 clear containers are totally wrapped in a plastic label. To recycle, simply cut a slit in the wrapper and peel it off.



Special Collection Containers for 3 types of #1 Clear Plastic

- **Blue Recycle Bins** - Containers for a blue recycle bin have a screw-top lid. Examples: salad dressing, mayo, ketchup, creamers; also, juices and waters 48 oz. and over. Do not include the screw-top lid in recycling.

- **Special Green Bins** - These plastics include clamshells, eg., berry (and other fruit and produce) and bakery or food items; also tubs/containers and cups with lids (not screw-top). The special green bins for these items are located at:
 1. South Main - at South end (delivery/refuse area).
 2. North Pocket - Refuse corral off Wild Rose Dr.
 3. Northwest - Refuse area north of carport/garage area.
 4. West Central - Refuse area by Alice Lane and Laurie Ave.
 5. The Oaks - Refuse corral. Can also be used by Rose Court and the Southeast apartments.
 6. Schroeder Lofts Garage - Located directly east of the elevator lobby.



- Special Collection Area for Oregon Refundables (clear plastic, aluminum, and glass) - Located on south end of South Main (area outside of the Art Studio). Plastic containers include all carbonated drinks, juices, waters and more. You'll find "OR 10¢" on the label. Also can be placed in orange bins located in all trash/refuse areas. Rose Villa has volunteers who take these for redemption. The money collected goes to the RV Foundation. That donation was \$3,640 in 2022 and will exceed \$4,000 in 2023.



NEWS FLASH FOR SPECIAL GREEN BINS: You may use these bins to recycle empty, clean and dry #6 (PS) plastic clamshells/containers and cups (like Harvest Grill salad dressing cups) and #6 (PS) white styrofoam meat trays.
