This relief organization accepts:

- Prescription and over-the-counter pill bottles
- Large and small pill bottles
- · Pill bottles with and without child-resistant caps

Preparation Guidelines:

- 1. Remove all labels, leaving no glue or residue (soak in hot soapy water, or boil in a pot of water, or microwave for ~6 or 7 seconds. Take care with very thin-walled see-through bottles, such as allergy pill bottles, which might melt or become misshapen).
- Remove remaining glue and residue with lemon oil or Goo-Gone.
- 3. Wash all bottles and lids in very hot water and dish soap, rinse, and dry thoroughly.
