#### **Ready Force Steering Committee Meeting Minutes**

Wednesday, June 4, 2024 Training Room

**Attending**: Margaret Bell, Jane Eggerstedt, Mary Eusterman, Marti Franc, Ed Gellenbeck, Jean Lofy, Roxanne Malter, Mayo Marsh, Jude Watson, and Louise Williams.

Many thanks to those who contacted Louise ahead of time to state whether they were attending or not.

- 1. Ed Gellenbeck and Louise Williams reported on the recent Executive Committee meeting with Glen Lewis and Jim Willeford. Topics included:
  - a. The Communications Plan with Rick Hamell. RV Staff will eventually join the Ready Force monthly radio drills led by Jude Watson on the first Tuesday of the month.
  - b. Emergency Food Plan with Norine Mulry. One main concern is where to store the emergency food.
  - c. Medical Triage Plan. Mary Eusterman, Marti Franc, and Jane Eggerstedt have formed a subgroup to investigate this. They are in the brainstorming phase right now. The group is considering medical triage in a neighborhood setting in addition to a main triage area located near the circle outside of Madrona Grove.
  - d. The Red Binder is due for an update in 2025 with collaboration from RV Inc. Jim stated that the Red Binder is a Ready Force project, but RVI staff will collaborate.
  - e. Watch for fire and multi-story evacuation information at a future Resident Forum.
- 2. May 14th was the first radio check-in with the new CERT-Lite Students. Jude Watson distributed seven radios to the recent graduates. Six new radios and five new batteries are on order. Jude agreed to run the next radio drill organized by Ready Force neighborhoods rather than by last name.
- 3. Norma Martin and Sally Sharrard will lead a food presentation on Friday, June 14th. It will be recorded and posted on RVillagers.org. So far, 22 people have signed up.
- 4. Four neighborhoods will redo the Map Your Neighborhood exercise this year. These neighborhoods last completed MYN in 2022.
  - a. North Main had a successful meeting on June 1
  - b. South Main will have theirs on June 15
  - c. Southwest will have theirs on June 22
  - d. South Central will have theirs on July 20

All MYN meetings will be in the Training Room at 10 am. All RF volunteers are invited to sit in or help with these events. It is fun to learn about the different neighborhoods and hear what is emphasized and what comes up in the discussions.

Following each session and collecting data from residents unable to attend, Ed will prepare and send a summary document to the Ready Force volunteers in that neighborhood that would be helpful if we have drills in the future.

Marti Franc is interested in having a Map Your Neighborhood meeting this fall for the Schroeder and Trillim neighborhoods. Holding this meeting in 2024 would be helpful as it would balance out the number of Map Your Neighborhood meetings we hold each year.

- 5. Jean Lofy reported that the Twin Bucket Project is finally completed. Ready Force sold 30 bucket sets at the ROSE Refresh Party. Many thanks to all who volunteered to help with this project: Pat Snider, Nancy Dorn, Jack Duren, Mary Eusterman, Marti Franc, Ed Gellenbeck, and Louise Williams.
- 6. Ed Gellenbeck and Louise Wiliams summarized the recent RV Foundation grant. The grant covered CPR training, new first aid kits, updated supplies, and vests and helmets for CERT-lite students. All the grant money has been spent.
- 7. Margaret Bell, Jane Eggerstedt, and Marti Franc volunteered to help collect the six bullhorns and remove their batteries. Jude Watson returned two bullhorns at the meeting. They will be refreshed with new batteries and stored in the RF garage.
- 8. Marti Franc briefly reported on a recent Oak Lodge CERT radio drill. The drill will be discussed further at the next meeting, focusing on applying it to Rose Villa.




